Ausi is a precious boy with severe hydrocephalus. His parents passed away when he was young and he was raised by his grandparents for some years; however, as they aged they were unable to continue caring for him. He has other family members, but due to his condition, they refuse to care for him. Therefore, the police brought him to Home of Hope where he could receive the love and care he deserves. Ausi is able to speak, both Lugandan and some English, and can also feed himself, but is fully dependent for things such as bathing and dressing.

Ausi is thriving at Home of Hope due to the nannies' love, nursing care and occupational therapy as well as daily meals. Ausi's occupational therapy sessions are focused on Ausi sitting independently and dressing himself independently. He attends a local day school near Home of Hope where he can interact with typical and special needs children and receive special education services. He currently receives sponsorship for his school, though he needs a sponsor for his care at Home of Hope.

Sponsorship for Ausi would provide for his daily needs, including meals, clothing, nanny care, occupational therapy sessions and quarterly checkups for his shunted hydrocephalus. The cost is \$45 per month via Paypal. Sponsorship includes updates on Ausi throughout the year and following Our Hope's annual trip to Uganda.
