Josam's mother was raped as a young girl and she became pregnant with Josam. She was an orphan herself, and thus struggled greatly to provide for Josam. The Home of Hope staff began seeing Josam while providing home visits in the community. It was discovered that he was severely malnourished and his mother was unable to properly care for him, so he was brought to Home of Hope.

Josam is capable of crawling and feeding himself. He is now receiving daily meals, nanny care, nursing care and occupational therapy sessions to help improve his functioning. It is hopeful that he will begin walking soon with the help of the occupational therapy sessions.

Sponsorship for Josam ensures he receives daily meals, clothing, occupational therapy sessions, nursing care when needed and helps provide for the staff that cares for him 24 hours a day.
