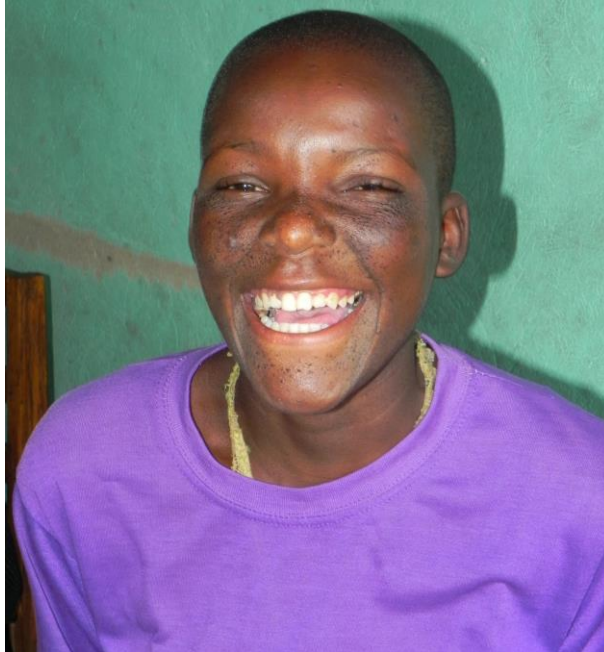


Lydia

Lydia is a girl with developmental delay who was attending Mt. Zion Primary School. After arriving at the school, it was realized that she needed a place to go during school breaks. So, she was brought to Home of Hope to live. She continues to attend Mt. Zion Primary School and is the Primary 3 (P3) class. She is a big help to her teachers and others. During breaks from school, when back at Home of Hope, she has become very helpful. She can help care for the other children, clean and do other miscellaneous tasks. Home of Hope and Our Hope International would like Lydia to attend a new school during the next school year, which begins in January. It is a vocational boarding school in the city of Entebbe. At this school, she can continue her education with a focus on vocational skills such as baking, laundry, cleaning, gardening, arts & crafts and more. This allows her to have a skill once completing so that she can find a job and care for herself.

Lydia currently has a school sponsor which pays for her tuition, including room and meals, while at her school, but it does not provide for her other needs, such as clothing, some school supplies and her meals and needs while at Home of Hope during school breaks, which is approximately 5 months of the year. The cost is \$45 per month via Paypal. Sponsorship includes updates on Lydia throughout the year and following Our Hope's annual trip to Uganda.
