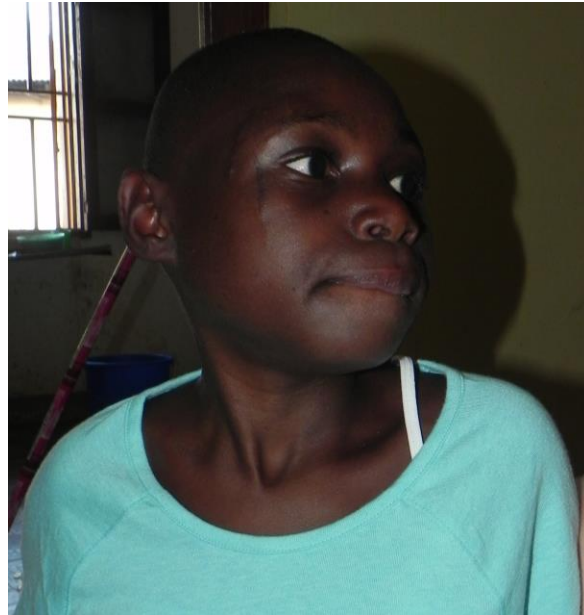


Shaminah

When that occurred, a neighbor attempted to help care for Shaminah, but was unable to do so. Local authorities were notified and brought Shaminah to Home of Hope.

Shaminah is capable of speaking, crawling, feeding herself, playing with toys and interacting with others. She would do well at school. She has difficulty with concentration, but the staff at Home of Hope are working with her to improve that. Home of Hope and Our Hope would like for Shaminah to attend the local day school where several of the other children attend. At this school, she can receive education in a special education classroom and also interact with her typical peers.

Shaminah needs sponsorship for both her daily care at Home of Hope and her school.
